

Course Description

A distinction must be made between implant survival and implant success. Survival means there is still some level of osseointegration of the implant in the bone. However, more discerning patients and dental teams have noted a host of complications that will not permit us to use the word "success" when describing many cases. Achieving long term esthetics, function, and peri-implant health has become more important as we raise the standards for implant therapy. It is simply not enough to achieve osseointegration anymore.



COURSE TITLE Infection Control in a Dental Healthcare Setting 1PM - 3PM

Course Style Lecture: 2 hours

Course Description



This course focuses on the importance of implementation of an evidencebased infection control/exposure control protocol based upon Standard Precautions and Transmission-based Precautions within the dental office to prevent or minimize healthcare-associated infections. Underlying sources of infection and best practices for reduction of infectious transmission will be discussed.

Learning Objectives

- Understand the rationale for and develop policies and practices intended to prevent or minimize healthcare associated infections in the oral healthcaresetting
- Discuss issues related to air, water and fomites as a source of infectious agents in the healthcare settings
- Understand the role of and implement vaccination strategies intended to reduce the risk of vaccine preventable diseases in the oral healthcare setting
- Understand the roles and implement the uses of personal protective equipment and appropriate hand hygiene
- Understand the role of and incorporate engineering and work practice controls to eliminate or isolate hazards in the workplace
- Understand the role of an implement environmental infection control to provide a safer work environment
- Understand the importance of post-exposure follow-up and associated policies and practices to reduce the risk of post-exposure infection
- Understand the principles of and implement transmission-based precautions to prevent the potential spread of specific diseases
- Discuss and implemt strategies for other issues related to envronmental infection prevention and control in healthcare settings

COURSE TITLE Oral Hygiene Controversies

"Flossgate", Oil Pulling, and Activated Charcoal Dentifrice: Oral Hygiene in the Age of Pinterest and Dr. Google

Course Description

Four of the top 5 results for a Google search for "Best Toothpaste" yield dentifrices that do not contain fluoride and are not approved by the American Dental Association (ADA). A Pinterest search for "Oral Hygiene" reveals everything from a recommendation for homemade bicarbonate toothpaste to oil pulling to a detailed description of the optimal method of flossing. In 2016 the Associated Press published an article entitled "Turns out Flossing is Overrated" claiming that there is no evidence that flossing affords an adjunctive benefit to brushing. With all of the information our patients are bombarded with, how do we help them develop an individualized course of oral home care practices and products that best suit their needs to optimize and maintain their oral health? This course focuses on an evidence-based, patient-centered approach to oral hygiene and an informed discussion of the vast array of oral hygiene products that our patients may be using.

- Address "Flossgate" questions generated by patients related to media coverage of the omission of flossing recommendations from the 2015-2020 U.S. Dietary Guidelines.

- Discuss with patients the optimal strategies and rationale for oral hygiene, including interdental cleaning.
